265 Mr. Bennett Miller explained to the Committee, Board and others present that the decision to deny an application  
266 for licensure by endorsement while allowing the applicant the opportunity to amend their application to licensure  
267 by examination without the applicant being present. Mr. Miller assured all present that the applicant in question  
268 will receive a Notice of Intent to Deny and be given the same opportunity to contest or accept the decision of the  
269 Committee and the Board. The applicant will receive the same considerations and rights regardless if they are  
270 present or not.

273 previously discussed applicants the opportunity to gather the requested information.
