52 **REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE JANUARY 16, 2003 PROBATION COMMITTEE**
53 **MINUTES**

55 The Committee reviewed the January 16, 2003 minutes and after discussion the following
56 motion was made.

58 MOTION: Mr. Armenteros made a motion to approve the January 16, 2003 probation
59 committee meeting minutes.
60 SECOND: Mr. Cooner seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

63 **REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION OF RENE AUGUESVIVES CORRESPONDENCE**

65 The committee reviewed Mr. Auguesvives' letter requesting that the board accept the MTS
66 course he completed through a correspondence.

68 MOTION: Mr. Cooner made a motion to deny Mr. Auguesvives' request for the board to
69 accept the MTS correspondence course.
70 SECOND: Ms. Nobles seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

72 **1st Set of Survey Review**

74 Carrol Godwin – Case #98-22612

75
76 Mr. Godwin was not present at the meeting and he was not represented by counsel. After
77 discussion the following motion was made.

79 MOTION: Mr. Lebron made a motion to table review of Mr. Godwin's case to the end of the
80 meeting.
81 SECOND: Mr. Armenteros seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

83 **2nd Set of Survey Review**

85 Edwin Matthews- #99-09938

86
87 Mr. Matthews was present at the meeting and was not represented by counsel. Mr. Armenteros
88 asked committee members to report their review.

89
90 Mr. Cooner reported he reviewed exhibits number 5 and 6. Mr. Cooner stated that the surveys
91 were not signed and sealed so surveys are not in compliance. Mr. Cooner stated the surveys
92 were invalid.

93
94 Ms. Nobles reported she reviewed exhibits number 3 and 4. Ms. Nobles stated that the surveys
95 were not signed and sealed and were not in compliance. Mr. Nobles stated that exhibit number
96 3 had 5 MTS violations and exhibit number 4 had MTS violations also.

97
98 Mr. Cooner stated he would go ahead and identify Mr. Matthews violation of exhibits number 5
99 and 6. Mr. Cooner reported exhibit number 5 had 5 MTS violations and exhibit number 6 had 7
100 MTS violations. Mr. Cooner stated Mr. Matthews is not being consistent with his surveys.

101
102 Mr. Armenteros reported he reviewed exhibit number 1 and 2. Mr. Armenteros stated he had a
103 problem in following Mr. Matthews field notes. Mr. Armenteros stated exhibits number 1 and 2
104 had 5 violations. Mr. Armenteros stated Mr. Matthews exhibits are not in compliance with board
105 rule.

106
107 Mr. Armenteros stated that in accordance with the final order the stay of suspension is lifted.
108

109 MOTION: Ms. Nobles made a motion to not accept Mr. Matthews' 6 surveys and suspend
110 Mr. Matthews' license.

111 SECOND: Mr. Cooner seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
112

113 The committee asked staff to forward the 6 surveys to the Department to initiate a complaint for
114 violation of minimum technical standards.

116 **1st Review of Surveys**

117 Carrol Godwin - #98-22612

120 Mr. Godwin was present at the meeting and was represented by Mr. Kirk Bauer. Mr. Bauer
121 addressed the committee. Mr. Bauer advised the committee that at the October 2002 meeting
122 the committee reviewed Mr. Godwin's surveys and the committee rejected 4 and accepted 2.
123 Mr. Bauer advised the committee that Mr. Gowdin had submitted the 4 surveys.
124

125 Mr. Armenteros reminded the committee that the review of the surveys was to serve as a 1st
126 review.
127

128 Mr. Cooner reported he reviewed exhibits number 5 and 6. Mr. Cooner stated exhibit number 5
129 had 6 minor violations and exhibit number 6 had minor violations. Mr. Cooner stated that
130 exhibits number 5 and 6 were in compliance.
131

132 Ms. Nobles reported she reviewed exhibits number 3 and 4. Ms. Nobles stated the information
133 Mr. Godwin submitted was confusing and she had tried to review the surveys but it would have
134 taken to much time and effort. Ms. Nobles stated she would state that the surveys were not in
135 compliance.
136

137 Mr. Armenteros reported he reviewed exhibit 1. Mr. Armenteros stated that exhibit number 1
138 was in compliance.
139

140 Mr. Cooner stated the exhibits he reviewed were not signed and sealed.
141

142 After discussion the following motion was made.
143

144 MOTION: Mr. Cooner made a motion to accept Mr. Godwin's 6 surveys and release him
145 from probation pending receipt of the 6 surveys signed and sealed.

146 SECOND: Ms. Nobles seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

148 149 Kenneth Monie - #97-17162

151 Mr. Monie was present at the meeting and was not represented by counsel.
152

153 Mr. Cooner reported he reviewed exhibit number 5 and 6. Mr. Cooner stated both surveys were
154 in compliance.

155
156 Ms. Nobles reported she reviewed exhibit number 3 and 4. Ms. Nobles stated both surveys
157 were in compliance.

158
159 Mr. Armenteros stated he reviewed exhibits number 1 and 2. Mr. Armenteros stated both
160 surveys were in compliance.

161
162 MOTION: Ms. Nobles made a motion to release Mr. Monie from probation.

163 SECOND: Mr. Cooner seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

165 **PROBATION SUMMARY REPORT**

167 The committee reviewed the probation summary report. Mr. Cooner asked if staff would check
168 to see if Mr. Joseph Smith was practicing.

169

170 The committee noted Mr. Serbu's corrected surveys were due that day. Mr. Ted Madson was
171 present at the meeting and Mr. Madson submitted the corrected surveys to the committee. Mr.
172 Madson asked Ms. Nobles if she would review the surveys during the meeting. Ms. Nobles
173 stated that the information was not received in time to review at the meeting.

175 There being no other business the meeting adjourned at 10:45 a.m.
