

# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

## **BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL SURVEYORS AND MAPPERS**

### **I. General Information**

Meeting dates: Committee/General Business Meeting October 8-9, 2003. The meeting was held at the Hawthorn Suites, Orlando, FL

Board members present: Pamela Nobles, Omar Armenteros, Dennis Blankenship, Jeffrey Cooner, Beverly Sutphin, Sidney Greer, Lou Bush, and Francis Poppell.

### **II. Major Issues/Actions**

- 6 disciplinary cases
- 3 informal hearing of application denials (2 applicants were approved and 1 applicant tabled to the January 2004 meeting)
- Board reviewed 4 applications by endorsement, 3 applications by examination (3 applications approved, and 4 applications denied)
- Probable Cause Panel reviewed 8 cases (5 cases probable cause was found, 2 cases were referred back to the Department for further investigation, 1 case was referred to an expert)
- Board reviewed Florida Environmental, Inc. petition for declaratory statement.
- Election of officers was held and Ms. Nobles was voted Chair and Mr. Blankenship was voted Vice Chair to be effective at the January 2004 meeting.

### **III. Legislation/Rule Promulgation**

- Board asked the Florida Surveyors and Mappers Society to forward a copy of the proposed legislative language supporting privatization when it was completed.
- Board is considering making changes to their continuing education rule 61G17-5, F.A.C.
