REVIEW AND DISCUSSION OF RULES

Rule 61G17-3.0021, F.A.C.

The board reviewed the proposed changes to Rule 61G17-3.021, F.A.C. Mr. Cooner asked Ms. Guillemette if the board could consider adopting the rule with a later effective date. Ms. Guillemette stated that the board could consider implementing a later effective date in the rule language. Mr. Cooner stated that there are students currently in the career path and implementing the new language would affect those students. It was the consensus of the board that the rule changes needed more thought and discussion.

After discussion the following motion was made.

MOTION: Ms. Sutphin made a motion to leave Rule 61G17-3.0021, F.A.C. as is and to drop adoption of the changes.

SECOND: Ms. Nobles seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Cooner suggested that the Rule Committee meet instead of having rule workshops at each meeting. Mr. Cooner stated that the Rule Committee could hammer out the language and then if the public had input, a workshop could be scheduled. The board agreed.

Rule 61G17-6.004, F.A.C.

Mr. Cooner stated that Ms. Oliver submitted a letter regarding Rule 61G17-6.004, F.A.C. and in her letter she addressed cap identification. Ms. Oliver was present at the meeting and she addressed the board. Mr. Cooner stated that the issue would need discussion and stated that he was not in support of discussion at this time. The board agreed and did not take any action.

Rule 61G17-9.004, F.A.C.

Ms. Guillemette advised the board that the JAPC brought up some concerns with the proposed changes to Rule 61G17-9.004, F.A.C. Ms. Guillemette advised the board that a letter of response was submitted to JAPC. The board reviewed the letter.

Mr. Hurst addressed the board stating Rule 61G17-9.0045, F.A.C. and 61G17-9.004 work together. Mr. Hurst suggested making changes to 61G17-9-0045, F.A.C. in addition to the changes to Rule 61G17-9.004 (2), F.A.C.

MOTION: Ms. Sutphin made a motion to request that Rule 61G17-9.0045, F.A.C. be noticed for rule development.

SECOND: Ms. Clodfelter seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

MOTION: Ms. Sutphin made a motion to delete section (1) of Rule 61G17-9.0045, F.A.C.

SECOND: Ms. Clodfelter seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

MOTION: Ms. Sutphin made a motion to approve Rule 61G17-9.004, F.A.C. proposed language with changes to section (2).

SECOND: Ms. Nobles seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Rule 61G17-3.0025, F.A.C.

The board reviewed the proposed changes to Rule 61G17-3.0025, F.A.C and after discussion the following motion was made.

MOTION: Ms. Sutphin made a motion to approve the proposed changes to Rule 61G17-3.0025, F.A.C. with changes. Ms. Sutphin stated that in section (1) the statute section should be corrected to reference Chapter 472 and in section (1) (e) the word filed should be corrected to "field".

SECOND: Mr. Greer seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Rule 61G17-5.0043, F.A.C.

The board reviewed the proposed changes to Rule 61G17-5.0043, F.A.C. Ms. Guillemette stated the proposed changes were considered technical changes and should move quickly.

MOTION: Ms. Sutphin made a motion to approve the technical changes to Rule 61G17-5.0043, F.A.C.

SECOND: Ms. Poppell seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Rule 61G17-5.001, F.A.C.

The board reviewed the proposed changes to Rule 61G17-5.001, F.A.C. and after discussion the following motion was made.

MOTION: Ms. Sutphin made a motion to approve the proposed changes to Rule 61G17-5.001, F.A.C.

SECOND: Mr. Greer seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

NEW/OLD BUSINESS

Harley Gilmore correspondence regarding Rule 61G17-5.0043 (11), F.A.C.

Mr. Gilmore was present at the meeting and addressed the board asking the board to consider changing the rule change to take out the requirement that requires the surveyor to affix their signature, date and seal to correspondence exams.

After discussion the following motion was made.

MOTION: Ms. Sutphin made a motion to remove the language in Rule 61G17-5.0043 (11) that requires the surveyor to affix their signature, date and seal to correspondence exams.

SECOND: Mr. Greer seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ms. Poppell addressed the board and stated that she would like to see a rule in place that requires business vehicles to have a sign identifying the name of the company.

Mr. Cooner stated he would place Ms. Poppell's item on the next agenda for discussion.
